## The Geneva Road Service

Geneva Road is a day service currently providing a service for around 60 disabled adults. The focus of the centre is group work and activities that promote wellbeing, have an educational value, are therapeutic and support service users in developing a high self-esteem.

The opportunities offered are very varied and include: visits to the gym, bowling, art and craft opportunities, cooking and life skills development, physiotherapy, massage, relaxation, drama, and many more. The programme of activity changes four times a year.

All staff are well trained and supported, they all use makaton, are qualified to undertake complex moving and handling and are fully committed to supporting each person get what they want out of their placement at the centre.
