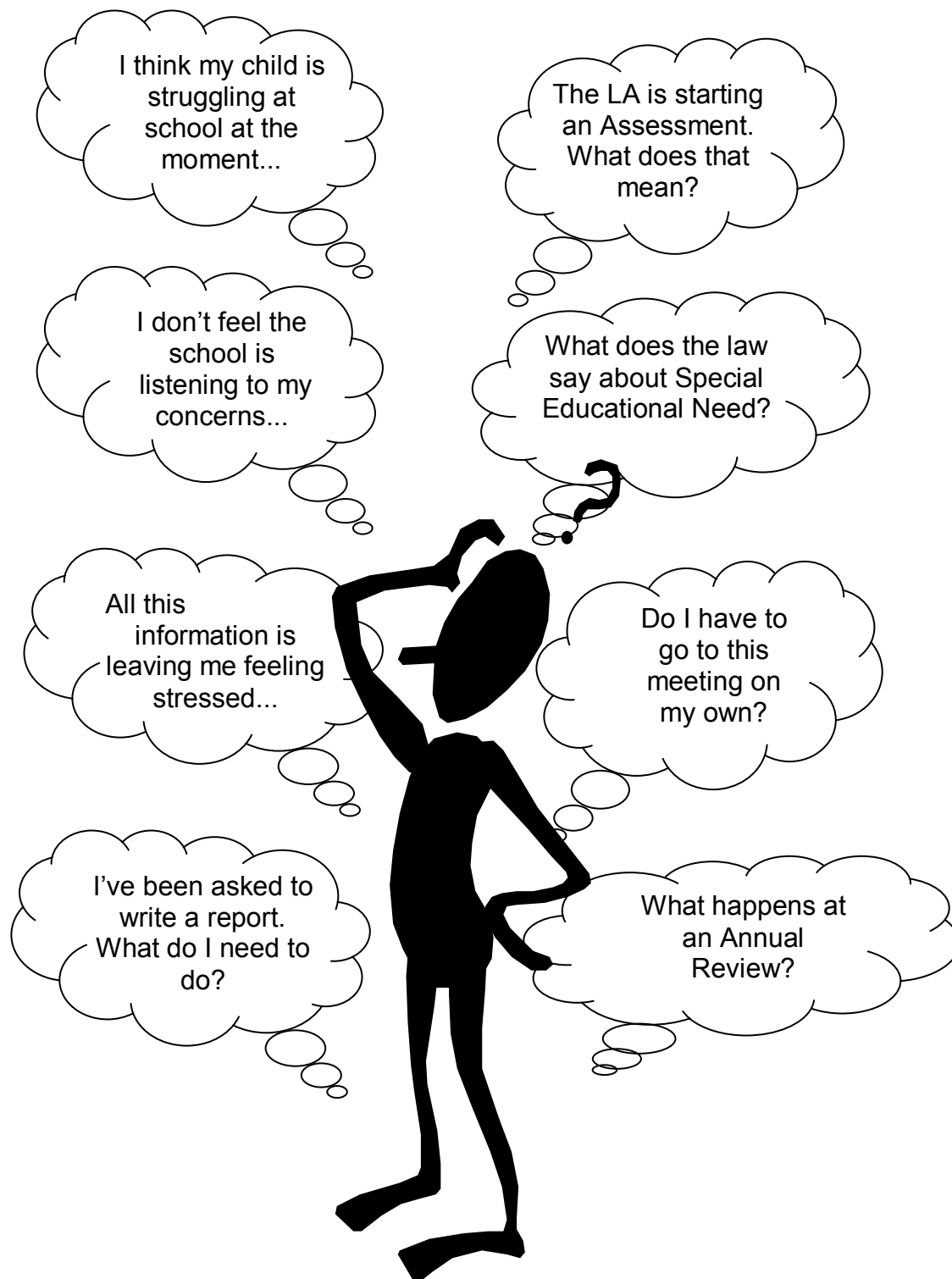

- ⇒ Puts you in touch with support groups or voluntary organisations that might be able to help.
- ⇒ Gives information about the law relating to Special Educational needs, the Assessment process, the SEN Code of Practice, and tribunals.
- ⇒ Supports you in discussing your child's needs with professionals.
- ⇒ Works with you to express your views in a positive way.
- ⇒ Listens to what matters to you and your child.
- ⇒ Explains reports, minutes and all information in a way you can understand.
